Dear ILWU-PMA Savings (401(k)) Plan Participant:

This notice is to inform you of a name change to one of the investment options available within the ILWU-PMA Savings (401(k)) Plan. Due to changes in ownership, the RCM Managed Equity (or Dresdner RCM Actively Managed Equity Fund) will be re-named to Voya US Large Cap Core Growth Fund. The fund will continue to be managed by the same investment manager, and maintain the same investment objective, strategy and risk. The only change at this time is to the name of the fund listed below.
