SLIPPING, TRIPPING AND FALLING FROM A SEMI TRACTOR ARE THE MOST COMMON WAYS OF GETTING HURT ON THE WATERFRONT.

Don't climb in holding your Lunch Pail, Tote Bag or Coffee Cup.

Don't Face out while climbing in or out of the tractor.

Don't Jump down.



YOU WILL END UP FLAT ON YOUR BACK ON THE PAVEMENT.

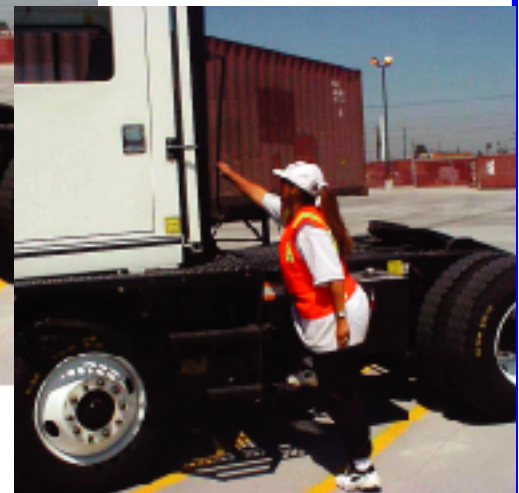
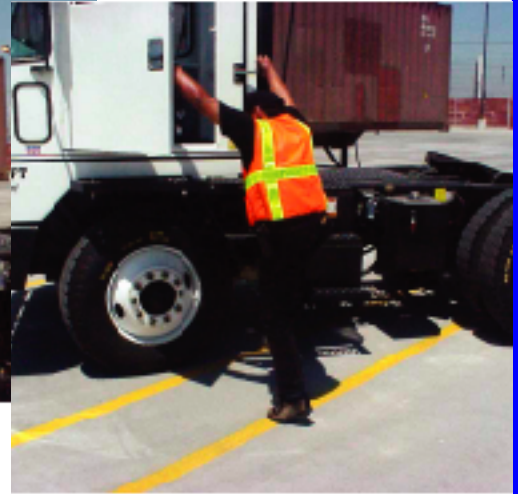

BE SAFE!!

1. FACE THE TRUCK (getting on and off)

4. WATCH OUT FOR GREASE AND OIL ON STEPS
5. DON'T JUMP OFF THE TRACTOR
