ELECTRIC PALLET JACK SAFETY




Inspect the Pallet Jack before use.

Keep hands/fingers inside handle guards.



- Only operate pallet jack if you have been instructed on proper and safe use.
 - Do not lift or hit anything that may fall on you or a bystander.
 - Keep feet clear of the pallet jack when in operation.
 - Keep yourself and others clear of the lift mechanism. Allow no one near load or lift mechanism.
 - · Look in the direction of travel & watch overhead clearances.
 - Always wear proper PPE when needed or required by your Employer.



Handle loads only within the rated load capacity of the pallet jack.

- Avoid bumps, holes, slick spots, and loose materials that may cause the pallet jack to swerve, tip or cause the control handle to jerk sideways. If unavoidable, travel slowly and carefully.
- When leaving the pallet jack, lower the forks, turn the key to OFF.
- Block the wheels when on an incline or working on the pallet jack.
 - Do not turn on an incline, loads may tip over.
 - Avoid sudden starts or stops which can damage the pallet jack or cause the load to fall off.
 - · Watch clearances, especially around forks.
 - Watch tail swing.
 - Remember the forks can sometimes extend beyond the load.

visibility,
whenever
possible, Travel
with forks
trailing.

When moving close to walls or into an elevator or fork lift cages, travel forks first.
