REQUIRED PPE ON MARINE TERMINALS

UNACCEPTABLE SAFETY VESTS



When working on a Marine Terminal, a safety vest must be worn at all times.

The vest must be of a high visibility color and made with reflectorized material.

If you purchase your own safety vest, it must comply with the ANSI 107-1999 standard. It will be listed on the tag.

Grey, Brown, Black and other dark materials are not considered a high visibility color.

Wear your PPE!

High Visibility Safety Vests must be worn at all times.

Hard Hats

PCMSC Rule 651 states that employees are required to wear a protective helmet at all times when working in areas where there is a potential for injury to the head from falling objects.



Safety Vest

PCMSC Rule 1154 states that employees working within a Marine Terminal shall wear a high visibility vest that is marked with reflectorized material.
